



White Wine - Australia

Unwooded Chardonnay 'Y Series', Yalumba - £10

*Fermented and matured in stainless steel vats,
this wine shows the true flavour of Chardonnay: clean, fresh and fruity.
Yalumba is a great winery and Australia's oldest family owned winery.*

Riesling 'The Lodge Hill', Jim Barry Wines, Clare Valley - £12.50

*Dry Riesling is very fashionable with fine food, especially East Asian influenced dishes.
Deep, concentrated lime zest flavours.
Jim Barry, founded in the 1950's, is one of Australia's great Riesling growers.*

Sauvignon Blanc Semillon, Vasse Felix, Western Australia - £13.50

*Western Australia produces some of the country's most elegant whites, and Vasse Felix,
one of WA's most celebrated wineries,
produce array of flavours of nectarine and melon with a citrus finish.*

Chardonnay, Chapel Hill, McLaren Vale - £12.50

*The McLaren Vale, overlooking Adelaide is a premium region
and Chapel Hill's winemaker, Michael Fragos, has won many awards for excellence.
Full, rich and Burgundian in style, this is high quality Chardonnay.*



White Wine - Chile

Sauvignon Blanc, Siete Soles Estate - £8

*Similar in style to New Zealand Sauvignon,
this is an exceptional value wine with intense, passion fruit and green pepper flavours.*

Chardonnay, Casa Lapostolle - £10

*Lapostolle is part of the same family that produce the liqueur Grand Marnier
and their intention is to bring classic French winemaking skills to the exceptional climate of Chile.
Smooth, rounded and rich with baked apple flavours.*



White Wine - France

Sauvignon Blanc, Vin de Pays d'Oc, la Prade - £8.50

*Aromatic and refreshing, this wine is dry, crisp and flavoursome, reminiscent of citrus fruits.
The hot climate in the vineyards, near Narbonne and Cap d'Agde,
produce wines with plenty of ripe, fruity flavours.*

Viognier, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Delas Frères - £10

*The Viognier grape is full flavoured yet crisp with soft, fruity flavours of peach.
Delas is an acclaimed producer, founded in 1835.*

Pinot Blanc d'Alsace, Domaine René Muré - £11

*A classic, food oriented wine with soft, smooth, white fruit flavours.
Muré is a highly respected estate, founded in the 16th Century.*

Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier - £14.50

*The great wine of the Loire Valley. Immaculately made, pungent, aromatic, refreshing citrus flavours.
Cherrier is a small, family owned estate committed to classic Sancerre wines.*

Chablis, Domaine Hamelin - £14

*A well-balanced Chablis with good fruit and depth from a small producer.
The estate's wine are described as "very pretty, very correct, very good".*

Saint-Véran, Domaine Saint Martin - £13

*The Côte Maconnais is known for good quality, good value Chardonnay wines.
The wine is unoaked and allows the pure expression of apple and pear flavours.*

Meursault Vieilles Vignes, Vincent Girardin - £24

*Vincent Girardin is one of the most dynamic young producers in this most famous of Burgundy villages.
Smooth, rich and stylish from full oak fermentation and maturation.*



White Wine - Italy

Gavi di Gavi 'La Meirana', Bruno Broglia - £13

*The Cortese grape achieves excellence in Gavi, south east of Turin in the northwest.
Fresh and fruity with a nutty flavour. Broglia is a top grower.*

Pinot Grigio 'Castel Firmian', Mezzacorona - £9.50

*The 16th Century Firmian castle overlooks these vineyards in the Trentino region.
This is a premium Pinot Grigio with plenty of fruity, pear-like flavours.*

Verdicchio di Castelli di Jesi Classico, Fattoria Laila - £10.50

*Fresh and fruity with lemon flavours and a nutty finish, ideal with fish and seafood.
A noted producer from the east coast near Ancona.*



White Wine - New Zealand

Sauvignon Blanc, Coopers Creek, Marlborough - £11.50

From Marlborough, the best region in the country for this grape variety.

Intense, pungent and packed with tropical fruit flavours.

Coopers Creek is a highly respected winery, established in the 1980s.
